

1. Start the TransitGenie application by pressing the “TransitGenie” icon.
2. Select your desired destination. Your origin is set by default to your current GPS location.
 - a. By default the “Favorites” tab will be selected. You can select “Current Location” to use your current GPS location, or select a pre-defined location from the “Favorites” list.
 - b. You can alternately select the “Map” tab at the bottom of the screen, and select your destination from the map directly. You can also type an address into the “Address” text field. You can save your location to the “Favorites” list by pressing the “Save” button.
 - c. You can alternately select the “Recents” tab at the bottom of the screen, and select your destination from the list of recently visited locations.
3. The four best routes from your origin to destination are now generated and displayed in summary form on the “Routes” screen.
 - a. The estimated time of arrival (ETA) and time until you need to depart are displayed in each row.
 - b. Select a row for more detailed route information.
 - c. **Optional.** If you wish to set your origin location to something other than the default “Current GPS location”, you can select the “Origin” text box, and follow the instructions in Step 2.
 - d. **Optional.** If you wish to personalize your routing options, press the “Settings” tab at the bottom of the screen. Here you can configure whether you are traveling with a bicycle, whether you wish to walk less at night, whether real-time route verification is enabled, and your desired walk speed.
4. The detailed route information screen displays the direction and duration of walk legs, and the board/alight information for each mode of transportation.
 - a. Buses using real-time verified departure/arrival times have black icons.
 - b. Buses using scheduled departure/arrival times have gray icons.
 - c. Buses whose departure/arrival times are in question have a question mark atop them.

- d. To view the route information displayed on a map, select the “Map” tab at the bottom of the screen.
5. The map displays step-by-step instructions for navigating from your origin to your destination.
 - a. Use the “Prev/Next” buttons to step through the route.
 - b. The map displays the real-time location of buses relevant to the current route.
 - c. Once you have reached your destination, the “Next” button will be grayed out.
